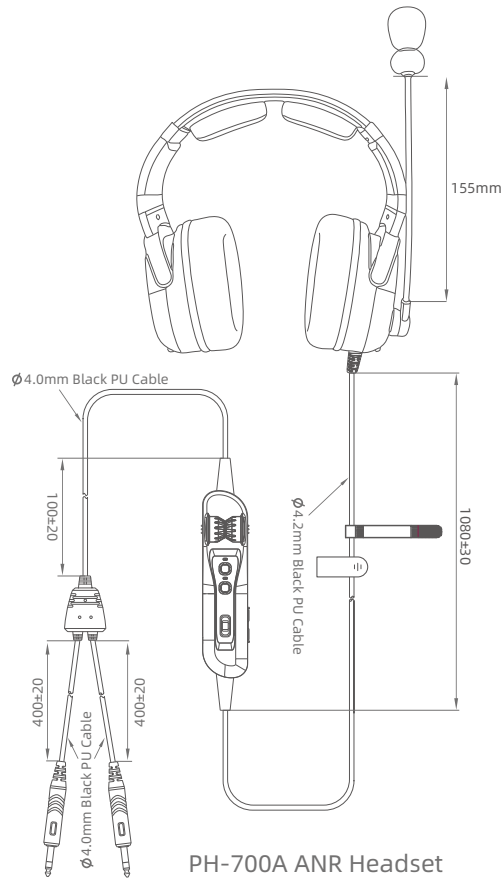

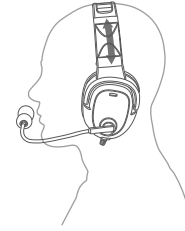

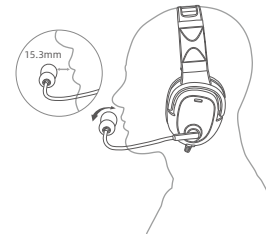
Operation Instructions



Locate the left (L) and right (R) icons inside the earcups to orient the headset properly.



Place the headset on your head. Adjust the headband so the ear cushions completely cover your ears.



Grasp the microphone base and adjust the boom so the microphone is positioned 0.6" (15.3 mm) from your lips.



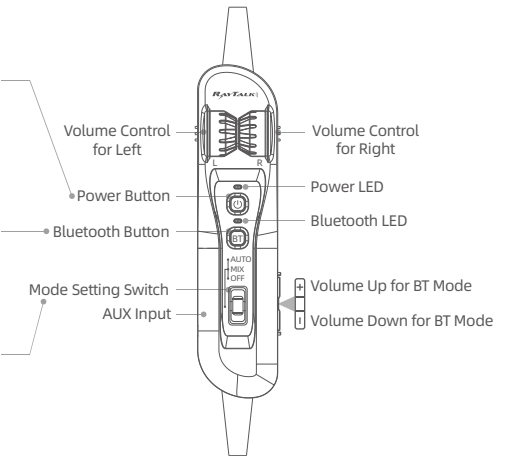
Place the headset in the carry case and position the mic over the headband to prevent boom chafing.

Press and hold Power button >2s to turn on or off.

Press and hold the Bluetooth button >2s to turn on or off. When turning on, press once after the prompt to enter pairing mode.

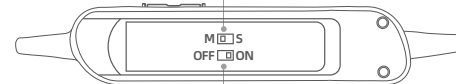
Call Handling
 Answer a call: Short press the Bluetooth button.
 End a call: Short press the Bluetooth button.
 Reject a call: Press and hold the Bluetooth button >1s.
 Redial last number: Double press the Bluetooth button.

3-Way Audio Priority Switch: AUTO) Intercom Priority, MIX) All Audio Sources, OFF) Intercom Only



Mono and Stereo switch

Default Setting: Mono Mode



Auto Power-Off Switch

ON: When the headset is not plugged into the intercom, it will turn off automatically after 1 h if music is playing, or after 10 min if no music is playing.

OFF: The headset remains on regardless of connection or playback status; no auto shut-down will occur.
